For the finals matches on June 24 and 25, tickets will be available for purchase on site. Tickets are \$5 per person each day. Cash is preferred. Again, indoor and outdoor seating will be available and there is no need to bring chairs or tents. There will also be a fun archery festival with a “Try Me” archery event, archery tag and skeet archery games.
